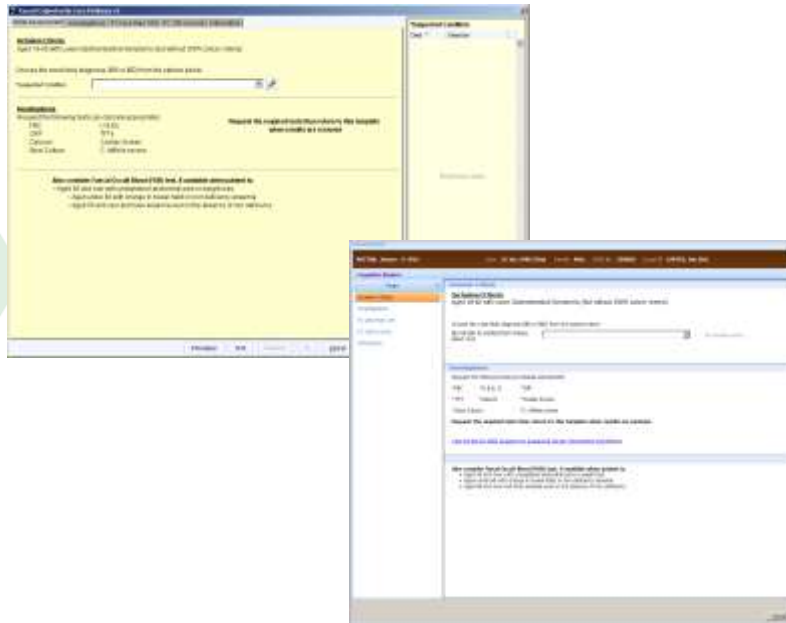




# Health Economics

- Analysed by YHEC



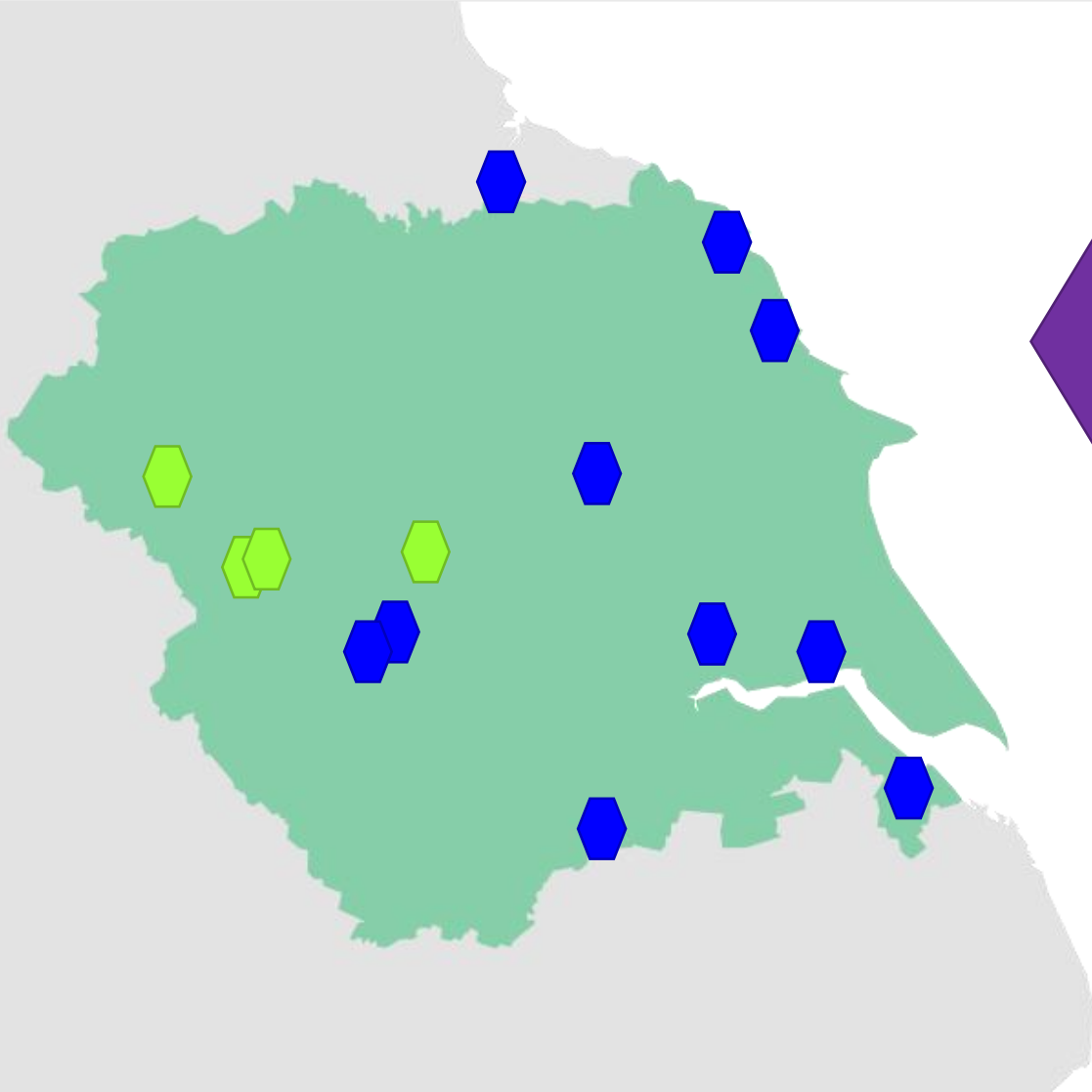
