
Having a good pathway is not enough to ensure take up

Health Economics

- Based on the outcomes of the first 1000 patients though York
- Analysed by YHEC

Pathway saves £60K-£145K per 1000 patients Avoids 147-262 colonoscopies, and 190-297 OP Appointments per 1000 patients



Roll out of the Pathway

Approximately 10 000 FC tests performed so far

3 STPs in Y&H Region engaged and ready supportive
