PDSAs and achievements

- First PDSA all midwives to be trained on monthly DTP (directorate training programme)
- Second PDSA change training to be community specific, monthly training in community teams which will take 4 months then train hospital staff
- Obtain baseline data for original needs, ask for more baseline data to answer questions which have arisen from more questions



SCORE Survey

- Wave 3:
- Senior team have reviewed SCORE results but nothing has been fed back to the workforce
- Made difficult by merger of 2 trusts, a lot of upheaval and many staff having to re-apply for their own jobs



Key challenges of the MatNeo Collaborative so far
