### Where are we now?


National AF Programme – ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.

#### **AF Prevalence**

- QOF 2019/20 is **2.34%**
- QOF 2018/19 is **2.25**%
- There has been an increase in the AF register size of **3,105** patients (from 70,022 patients in 2018/19 to 73,127 patients in 2019/20).

## **Detection – next 3 years**

#### **AliveCor: impact across NENC**

- 470 Lead 1 devices
- April 2018 June 2020
  - 50,546 traces taken
  - 3,408 possible AF detected
  - 170+ strokes saved
  - Over £7.8M cost saved
