Digital Solutions Implement a world-class IT system to use across the region to improve communication and provide integrated care for staff.

Service Model Design a service that provides a gold-standard of care in OH and Wellbeing for staff across the region.

Communication Co-design requires working with OH staff, OH leads, HR directors, line managers and staff across the trusts.

Metrics Standardising metrics across the four trusts to ensure the benefits of OH are seen to everyone.

Career Pathway Create a pathway to attract, develop and retain OH staff.
