

Research Plans

The Use of Restraints in UK Secure Forensic Psychiatric Services – From the Views of Service Users, Staff and Carers/Family

Phase 4 restrain risk. Phase 9 views 0 service

To investigate the use of restraints in secure forensic inpatient psychiatric services, with a focus on:

- (1) whether restraints are used in direct proportion to service users' actual or assessed level of risk and,
- (2) the environmental factors in the lead up to the use of restraints.

Phase 1: Analysis of CNTW NHS Trust's HCR-20 and log of restraints to explore any correlational relationship.

Phase 2: Analysis of CNTW NHS Trust's clinical data and logs of restraints to explore service users' characteristics, staff characteristics, environmental factors and other contextual information.

Phase 3: Focus Group with Service Users to explore views on restraints and its proportional relation to their risk.

Phase 4: Focus Group with Staff to explore views on restraints and its proportional relation to service user risk.

Phase 5: Focus Group with Family/Carers' to explore views on restraints and its proportional relation to service user risk.
