DTAC process

3 steps

Prepare your evidence

- Using standards laid out above
- Use the Innovation Service

Go into procurement with your evidence

- You are DTAC ready
- You will need to provide evidence before you are procured

Update your evidence

- Be on top of expired certifications
- E.g., penetration testing
- Update your customers with the evidence

DTAC myths

DTAC is a certification

It is a checklist of standards. You cannot be issued with a DTAC certificate.

DTAC is for new tech

Health IT which are already deployed within the NHS will be reviewed for DTAC at the time of contract renewal.

DTAC is not required for registered medical devices

Medical devices need to go through the MHRA assurance process. But Health IT need to meet DTAC requirements too.

The entry criteria are high

These are basic standards. They are GCSE Maths and English. They should be baked in by design.

DTAC is assessed centrally

DTAC should be reviewed as part of the procurement process. (Very few are assessed centrally as part of specific NHSE programmes)

DTAC isn't mandatory

DTAC includes standards that are mandated by law:

- Data Protection Act 2018 (for GDPR)
- Health and Social Care Act 2012 (Section 250)
- Medical Devices Regulations 2002 (For MHRA)
- Equality Act 2010 (Section 20 (6))
- Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018
