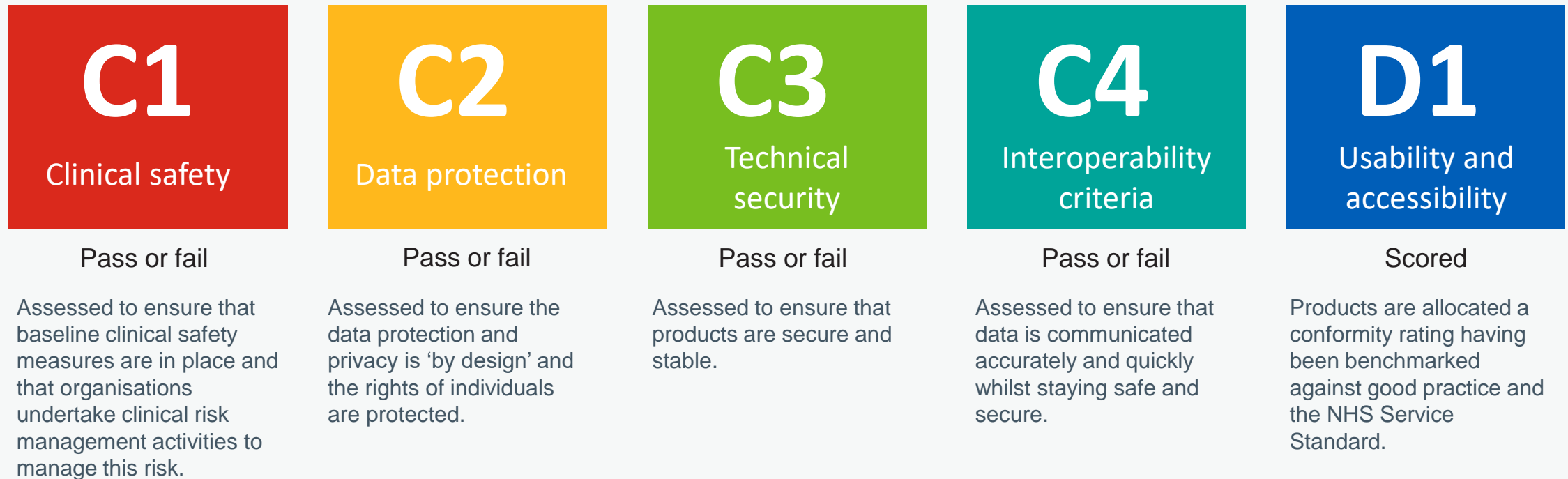

## 5 core components



# What is DTAC?

## 5 core components

**C1**

Clinical safety

Pass or fail

- DCB0129 compliance
- Clinical risk management system
- Clinical safety case report and hazard log
- Clinical safety officer in place
- MHRA registration
- Third party components

**C2**

Data protection

Pass or fail

- ICO registration
- Data Protection Officer nominated
- PID and sensitive data
- DPIA
- Data sovereignty and residency
- Data Security & Protection Toolkit (DSPT)

**C3**

Technical security

Pass or fail

- Cyber Essentials certificate
- Pen test report for previous 12 months
- Custom code security review
- Privileged accounts MFA access
- Logging and reporting defined
- Load testing report

**C4**

Interoperability criteria

Pass or fail

- Secure APIs
- NHS number to identify patient data
- NHS Login use
- EHR record integration
- Wearable device ISO/IEEE 11073 PHD standard

**D1**

Usability and accessibility

Scored

- NHS Service Standard adherence
- WCAG 2.1 level AA adherence
- NHS Internet First policy adherence

# DTAC process

## 3 steps

### Prepare your evidence

- Using standards laid out above
- Use the Innovation Service

### Go into procurement with your evidence

- You are DTAC ready
- You will need to provide evidence before you are procured

### Update your evidence

- Be on top of expired certifications
- E.g., penetration testing
- Update your customers with the evidence

# DTAC myths

## DTAC is a certification

It is a checklist of standards. You cannot be issued with a DTAC certificate.

## DTAC is for new tech

Health IT which are already deployed within the NHS will be reviewed for DTAC at the time of contract renewal.

## DTAC is assessed centrally

DTAC should be reviewed as part of the procurement process. (Very few are assessed centrally as part of specific NHSE programmes)

## DTAC is not required for registered medical devices

Medical devices need to go through the MHRA assurance process. But Health IT need to meet DTAC requirements too.

## The entry criteria are high

These are basic standards. They are GCSE Maths and English. They should be baked in by design.

## DTAC isn't mandatory

DTAC includes standards that are mandated by law:

- Data Protection Act 2018 (for GDPR)
- Health and Social Care Act 2012 (Section 250)
- Medical Devices Regulations 2002 (For MHRA)
- Equality Act 2010 (Section 20 (6))
- Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018
