# The AHSN Network

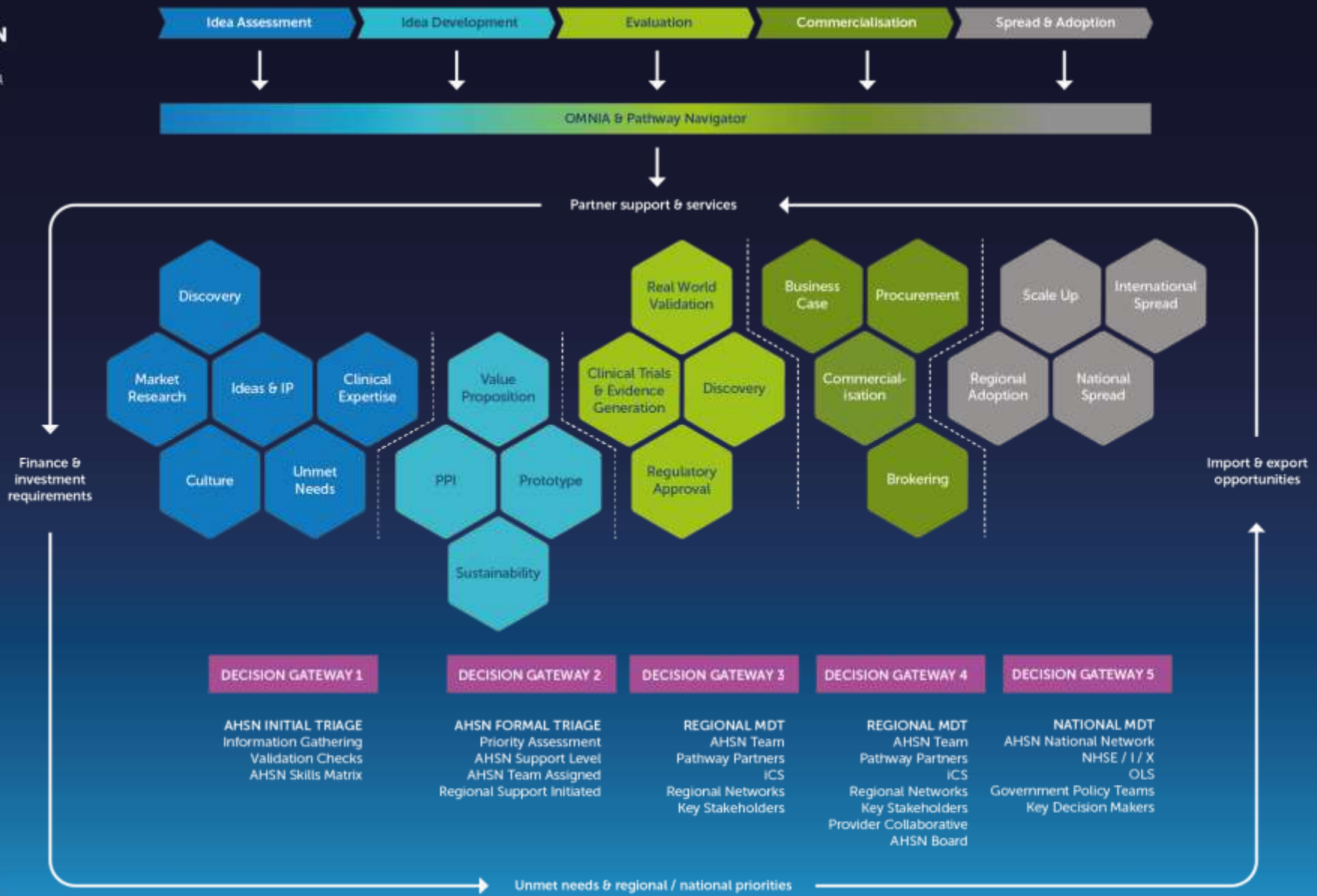
- **15** regional Academic Health Science Networks (AHSN), established by NHS England in **2013** to spread innovation at pace and scale
